

At Cross Roads OBX we take those words to heart. We have positively and personally impacted more than 150 lives within our community. This translates to close to 500 encounters in providing assistance or financial services in the form of: detox and rehab placement, temporary lodging, rent assistance, medication, transportation, and clothing. More importantly, we have connected 32 people with a local church including 13 professing a first-time or renewed relationship with Jesus Christ!

We work towards connecting individuals in need with a Christ-centered "Friend" who will enable them to experience a "P.L.A.C.E." of safety and acceptance: Playful, Loving, Accepting, Curious and Empathic relationships.

We also provide group, business, and individual training on the use of Narcan.

As we look back on 2022 and forward to 2023, one thing is evident: With God, All Things Are Possible! We confidently know this to be true as we continue to see it worked out daily.

Who We Are: Our organization exists to serve those who are most in need within our community, whatever that need might be. However, we are seeing a growing demand to help those trapped by drug or alcohol addiction. Cross Roads reaches out to offer compassion and direction to people wanting to change the course of their lives - to help them reestablish a sense of purpose and belonging in relationships with self, God, and loved ones, and to focus on choosing to connect with a healthy community. Our "friends" outreach has grown exponentially over the past year, and we project that this growth will continue.

How We are Different: There are numerous organizations within Dare County who provide support for individuals suffering with substance abuse. Services include emergence response for food, shelter, and transportation. Despite all these efforts and good work there is still more that can be done. Cross Roads' Peer Support Specialists are trained to address emergency needs and connect people to resources found inside and outside of Dare County. We work closely with the Dare County Health Department who acknowledges that our ability to address emergency services is essential and is saving lives.

Changing Lives Forever: Our team has touched the lives of more than 150 of our friends and neighbors seeking assistance. This translates to close to 500 encounters in providing services or financial assistance like securing detox or rehab placement, temporary lodging, rent assistance, medication, transportation, and clothing. But MORE importantly we have connected 32 people with a local church, with 13 professing a first-time or renewed relationship with Jesus Christ!
